## THE EASTER SEASON

The Church season of Easter starts on Holy Saturday Night/Easter Sunday and lasts for fifty days.

There are many special and important days that occur during the season of Easter. Cut out the feast days below and put them in the correct order on a separate sheet, or in your religion copy.

**April 11<sup>th</sup>:** Divine Mercy Sunday, when we celebrate that Jesus always loves and forgives us.

**May 14<sup>th</sup>:** The Feast of St Matthias, the apostle chosen by the remaining eleven apostles to replace Judas Iscariot following Judas' betrayal of Jesus.

**April 30<sup>th</sup>:** The Feast of St Catherine of Sienna. St Catherine was born in Italy and is the patron saint of Europe.

**May 1<sup>st</sup>:** The Feast of St Joseph the Worker. St Joseph was a carpenter.

**April 23<sup>rd</sup>:** The Feast of St George, patron saint of England.



**May 23<sup>rd</sup>:** The feast of Pentecost, fifty days after Easter Sunday. It is the day when we celebrate the coming of the Holy Spirit on the apostles. The Holy Spirit comes to us in Baptism and in the sacrament of Confirmation.
