SCRIPTURE READING

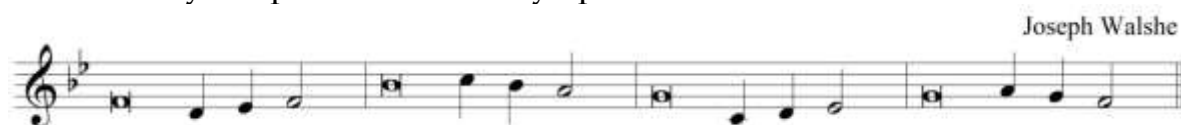
Philippians 3:20b-21
