# 2. HOW OUR FAITH CAN HELP US KNOW WE ARE UNIQUE AND LOVED RESOURCE SHEET

- 1. Letter from God Handout Reflection Time
- 2. Letter from God on YouTube clip (9mins 59sec)
- 3. Written Task- Text message to God- Reflection
- 4. YouTube clip -Song God and Dog (1min 59sec)

### **Letter from God:**

Introduce the letter. Quotations from the Bible. Point out that the quotes from the Old Testament are from the Jewish tradition. How human love is fallible, God's love is perfect.

Each student quietly reads the pages. Music can be softly played in the background.

Ask each student to choose one sentence that really stood out for them. Write it in their copies and say why this sentence struck them.

Share what they have written with the class

## **Sample questions:**


- **1.** Did a different line stand out for them this time? Write it down. Why do you think a different line struck you this time?

#### **Reflection:**

Students write a text message back to God. Private for their own reflection.

Note: Islamic and Jewish faith do not stress a close personal relationship with God.
